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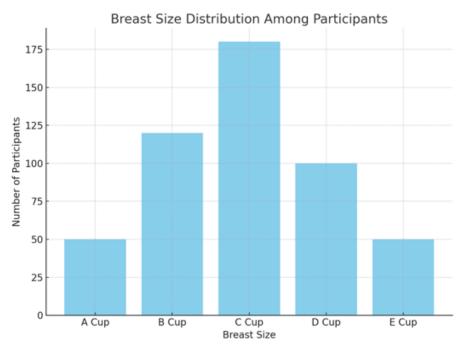


Figure 1: Breast Size Distribution among Participants.

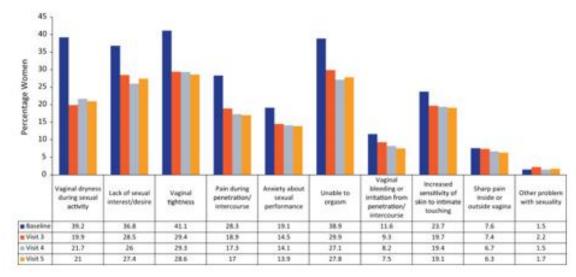
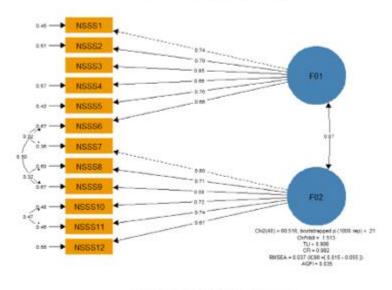


Figure 2: Correlation between Vaginal Size and Sexual Satisfaction.
